2021 AUSIT Victorian Branch AGM - Financial Statement

Official data for branches will be released by National Council at the AUSIT National AGM, therefore only indicative figures will be presented at our annual Victorian AGM. For full details, please refer to the official financial report which will be made available in time for the National AGM.

As foreshadowed by last year's Treasurer, this financial year has produced fairly unusual results due to the impact of the CoVid pandemic. Our Branch's main income stems from Professional Development and the past 12 months have seen all Victorian PD delivered online, which is in stark contrast to prior years. This means that expenditure on PD events was significantly reduced due to the lack of venue hire and/or catering expenses.

In total, the Victorian branch delivered a total of four PD events over this period, generating a surplus of \$3,437. This surplus will go into the national coffers as a contribution to the running costs of AUSIT in general. We anticipate a similar result for next financial year.

My brief experience as Branch Treasurer is about to end as I have relocated interstate, but it will be my pleasure to welcome a new Treasurer on board for 2021-22.
