## **Completion instructions:**

- A member intending to assign a proxy should first check that the person who will be holding the proxy is willing to accept that role, and confirm that they have the correct email and phone information..
- The person assigning the proxy should fill in <u>all</u> required information (including the information relating to the person who will be holding the proxy) **before** signing the form.
- Note that once the form has been signed, any fields / boxes not completed cannot be changed / added to.
- The person assigning the proxy should **save the form** by replacing '[name]' in the filename with their own surname before submitting the form.
- While this is not mandatory, the person holding the proxy should be given a copy of the completed form.
